July 8th 1880 the same being the fourth judicial day thereof
There were present officers as of yesterday and
after due proclamation of the opening of the Court
by the proper officers the following proceedings were

Liquor License
Cottrill Ed Beard

Now on this day comes the Petition of
Cottrill Ed Beard praying the Court to grant a License
to sell spirituous liquors in quantities less than one quart
at their place of business in Weston Wmatilla County Oregon.
And it appearing to the Court from the papers & proofs
filed herein that the law has been fully complied
with in the matter, and that due notice had been
given by the posting of notices as law required and
a good and sufficient bond given, and no re-
monstrances having been filed against said Petition
It is therefore ordered by the Court that the Clerk of
this Court issue a License to said Cottrill Ed Beard
to sell spirituous liquors in quantities less than
one quart in the town of Weston for a period of
Six months from the 8th day of July A.D. 1880 to the
8th Day of January A.D. 1881.
