RESOLUTION

TO ALL PERSONS TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS heretofore this court adopted a resolution dated June 19, 1924 for the relocation and straightening of the County road running through the lands of Edgar L. Smith and wife, in Umatilla County, Oregon as more particularly described in said resolution and directing by said resolution that the District Attorney of Umatilla County, Oregon, bring an action to condemn said right of way

AND WHEREAS the said Highway has been located and actually constructed through the lands of said Edgar L. Smith and wife, upon the right of way described in said resolution and the said new highway has been and is now actually open for travel of the general public and it is desired by this resolution formally to declare the old highway outside of the boundaries of the new highway as described in said resolution and situate within the property of the said Edgar L. Smith and wife, vacated and closed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the County Court of the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, sitting at the regular monthly term for the month of October, 1924, in the County Court room of the county court house in Pendleton, Umatilla County, State of Oregon for the transaction of county business, that it be and hereby is declared to be the intention of the said county court in said matter of the straightening of and re-location of the said highway through the lands of far as they lay outside of the boundaries of the new right of way as described in said resolution abovereferred to, be vacated and closed, and the title thereto revert to the said Edgar L. Smith and wife as the owners of the adjoining land.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said District Attorney aforesaid be and he hereby is authorized in the action pending for the condemnation aforesaid of said new right of way to offer and tender in said action that the said old right of way, vacated as above stated, be expressly decreed by the final decree and order in said action be vacated to the owners of the adjoining property as above stated and that said final decree in said action so provided and that the county expressly waives any right, title and interest in the said old right of way so far as the same lies outside of the boundaries of the said highway as constructed and as described in the said resolution of June 19, 1924
