now on this day comes the Report of the Viewers, Lew Anderson, Ed Smith and John Orton, heretofore appointed at the May, 1897, term, of this Court to view out and report upon the location of the above Road as a County Road for final hearing, the same having been read upon a previous day of this Court to-wit: the July, 1897 term. said road being described as follows: Commencing at the S.W. corner of Sec 2, in T4 S, N. R. 32 E. W. M. Thence running North on Sec line to half Sec cor of Sec. 26, Twp 6, N. R. 32 E. W. M. Thence East 1/2 mile to center of said Sec 26, Th. N. about 3/4 of a mile to Canyon. Th down Canyon and around the hill on the most practicable route to Canon Station on the Washington and Columbia River R. R. said road to follow said lines as near as practicable. said road to be 60 feet wide, and the said viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of the same as a County Road, and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same and there being no remonstrance or claim for damages on file against said road.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the report of said viewers be accepted and that the said road be established as a County Road in accordance with the report of said viewers, and that the said report, field notes, and plat of survey thereof, be recorded as by law required, and that the Supervisor through whose District said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road.
