In the Matter of Locating, Establishing Altering, :
Widening, Straightening, and Changing a County
Road in Township 2 North, Range 33, E.W.M. :

R E S O L U T I O N.
County Road No. 902.

TO ALL PERSONS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable that a County Road or Highway be located, established altered, widened, straightened and changed as hereinafter described, and that said road or Highway be located, established, altered, widened, straightened and changed by Resolution of the County Court of Umatilla County, State of Oregon.

And whereas this being a regular term of the Umatilla County Court and the said Court being now in regular session sitting for the transaction of county business.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Court of Umatilla County, State of Oregon, sitting in the regular monthly term for the month of March, 1931, in the county Court Room of the Umatilla County Court House in Pendleton, Umatilla County, State of Oregon, for the transaction of County business that it is and is hereby declared to be the intention of the said county Court to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten and change a road or high-way on and over a route as follows:

Beginning at a point 481.8 feet south of the southeast corner of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 2 N, Range 33 E.W.M., thence around a 52° curve right for a distance of 145.9 feet; thence along a tangent with a bearing of approximately North 76° East for a distance of 1195.6 feet; thence around an 8° curve right for a distance of 100.4 feet; thence along a tangent with a bearing of approximately S89° East for a distance of 2577 feet to an angle point with central angle of 0°15' right; thence along a tangent with a bearing of approximately S88° 45' East for a distance of 1348.8 feet to an angle point with a center angle of 0° 42' right; thence along a tangent with a bearing of approximately East for a distance of 5285.7 feet to a point which is the NW corner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Township 2N, Range 33, E.W.M.

Said road or highway to be a strip of land 40 feet wide being 20 feet wide on each side of the center line of the proposed road along the above described line, a detailed map and plat of said road and highway as surveyed being on file in the office of the Umatilla County Roadmaster in the Umatilla County Court House.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the establishment, alteration, and change of the road or highway as above described is public necessity for the reason that residents along and in the vicinity of the said proposed road require the same in order to secure egress to and from their property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above entitled matter be heard at the regular April Term for the year 1931 of said County Court at the County Court House at Pendleton, in the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, on the 15th day of April, 1931, at the hour of 10 o'clock A.M. of said day.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that true copies of this resolution, properly certified to as such by the County Clerk, be posted by the County Roadmaster as follows; to-wit: that one copy be posted upon the bulletin board in the west corridor in the County Court House in Pendleton, Oregon, said Court House being where the County Court is held and that three copies be posted in three public places in the vicinity of the said proposed road and that this resolution be duly entered in the Commissioner's Journal of the above entitled Court.

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In the Matter of legalizing a County Road through lands of Ernest M. Temple and Fred Young in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Twp. 2N, Range 33, E.W.M.

WHEREAS Ernest M. Temple and Maud Temple his wife, by their deed of conveyance dated March 12, 1931, conveyed to Umatilla County, Oregon, in consideration of \$125.00 to them paid by said county, a strip of land sixty feet wide, being thirty feet wide on each side of the center line of the permanent road survey of The Mission-Cayuse-Thorn Hollow Market Road as surveyed over and across the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Twp. 2 N. Range 33, E.W.M. particularly described as beginning at a point on the north line of the above described property, said point being station 71+22 of the survey, thence proceeding in a southerly direction a distance of 1078 feet to an intersection with a center line of County Road No. 747, and

WHEREAS Fred R. Young and Mae Young, his wife, by their certain conveyance dated the 10th day of March, 1931, in consideration of \$500.00 conveyed to Umatilla County, Oregon, a strip of land sixty feet wide, being thirty feet wide on each side of the center line of the survey of said road as now surveyed over and across the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Twp. 2 N, Range 33, E.W.M., beginning at station 58+65 of the survey and proceeding around a 20° curve to the right, a distance of 106.6 feet; thence along a tangent in a southerly direction a distance of 442.7 feet; thence around a 6° curve to the right a distance of 232.7 feet; thence along a tangent in a southerly direction a distance of 378.9 feet; thence around a 2° curve to the left a distance of 96.1 feet to station 71+22 of said survey, which point is upon the south line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 11, Twp. 2N. Range 33, E.W.M., and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the County Court of Umatilla County, State of Oregon, to at this time accept said deeds of conveyance and the land thereby conveyed as and for a public highway for said Umatilla County, Oregon.

WHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the county court of Umatilla County, State of Oregon, sitting for the transaction of County business, this 13th day of March, 1931, that
