ORDER.

IT IS ORDERED that the County Judge and County Commissioners of this county in their character as the county court sitting for the transaction of county business, do present a petition to the Honorable Secretary of the Interior of the United States asking him to cause to be laid out and established over and across the Umatilla Indian Reservation in this county five certain public roads in accordance with the survey and plat thereof made by J. W. Kimbrell, County Surveyor, during the last \_\_\_\_\_ months, the field notes and plat of which surveys are this day laid before this Court, said petition to be in the form now presented to the Court and this day signed by the members thereof in their official capacity, and to have the seal of the county affixed thereto by the Clerk and to be filed with the Indian Agent in charge of the Indian Reservation aforesaid.
