Known as the Old Oregon Trail Highway

Know all men by these presents, That Charles Serell and Ida Serell, his wife,

of the County of Umatilla

in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One Dollar

paid to them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,

have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto

the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in

the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land Eighty (80) feet wide, being Forty (40) feet on

each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across

the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 24, Township 2 North, Range

33 East, Willamette Meridian. And more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the west boundary of said property, which is 1201.4 feet south and 7.3 feet west of the center of ~~1/4~~ section 24, T. 2 N., R. 33 E. W.M. M.; thence south 0° 21' west a distance of 105.0 feet, more or less, to the north right of way line of the present existing county road; thence south 89° 39' east a distance of 33.7 feet; thence on a 5770.0 foot radius curve ~~1/4~~ left, the long chord of which bears north 17° 23' west a distance of 110.4 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, containing .04 acres, more or less.
