the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit:

#5. A strip of land 60 feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of the center line of the Columbia River Highway as surveyed over and across the Southeast Quarter of Section 25, Tp. 2 North, Range 33 E. of the W. M., and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the North boundary line of the Violet Bourner Chadsey property and the Columbia River Highway, at Station 492 / 41.8 of the survey of the center line of said Highway which station is approximately 29.2 feet south and 1680.0 feet west of the quarter corner between Sections 25 and 30, Tp. 2, North, Range 33 E. of the W. M.; running thence in a Southeasterly direction 1077.2 feet, more or less, to the intersection with the East boundary line of the Violet Bourner Chadsey property, at Station 503 / 19.0 of said survey which station is approximately 1054.4 feet south and 1352.5 feet west of the quarter corner between sections 25 and 30, Tp. 2 North, Range 33 E. of the W. M. containing 3.34 acres, more or less.

#7. A strip of land 60 feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of the center line of the Columbia River Highway as surveyed over and across the Southeast Quarter and the Southwest Quarter of Section 25, Tp. 2 North, Range 33 E. of the W. M.; and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the East boundary line of the Violet Bourner Chadsey property, and the Columbia River Highway, at Station 515 / 49.0 of the survey of the center line of said Highway which station is approximately 1772.6 feet south and 1338.3 feet west of the quarter corner between Sections 25 and 30, Tp. 2 North, Range 33 East of the W. M.; running in a Northwesterly direction 2427.1 feet more or less to the south boundary line of the Violet Bourner Chadsey property at Stations 539 / 76.1 of said survey, which station is approximately 1327 feet North and 461.9 feet west of the quarter corner between Sections 25 and 36, Tp. 2 North, Range 33 E of the W. M., containing 3.34 acres, more or less.
