In the Matter of ACCEPTING a Deed of Dedication and Relinquishment of Title to certain relocated County roads, frontage roads and abandoned State roads per a 1967 agreement between Umatilla County and the Oregon State Highway Division.

ORDER

WHEREAS the Oregon State Highway Division has constructed or reconstructed a portion of I-80N (Pendleton-Emigrant Hill Section, Old Oregon Trail Highway), and WHEREAS said construction or reconstruction has caused the alteration or relocation of certain county roads, plus the construction of frontage roads, and WHEREAS Umatilla County and the State of Oregon on July 24, 1967, entered into an agreement whereby Umatilla County agreed to assume all maintenance, jurisdiction and control of said roads, and

WHEREAS said Pendleton-Emigrant Hill Section, Old Oregon Trail Highway, has been completed, and

WHEREAS on July 8, 1975, Umatilla County accepted jurisdiction of said roads, and WHEREAS the Oregon State Highway Division is now submitting for filing its Deed of Dedication and Relinquishment of Title to said roads, now therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Deed of Dedication and Relinquishment of Title as presented be accepted and filed for record.
