Now on this day comes the Report of W. O. Warren, J. B. Kennedy & L. M. Figg the viewers heretofore appointed by the Court to determine how much less the value of the lands of W^m Preston would be rendered by reason of the location of the above mentioned road as a County road for final hearing, the same having been read on a previous day of this term, & it appearing from said report, that said viewers duly met at the time and place appointed & were duly qualified before entering upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf, & it further appearing from said report that the said viewers have estimated & appraised that no damage has been sustained to the lands of the said W^m Preston by reason of the said road crossing his lands.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the report of the said viewers be accepted & that the road be established in accordance with said report & that the Road Supervisor through whose district said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road.
