Field Notes of the survey of County road No. 234, Umatilla County, Oregon:

- Set sawed fir post 4x4x42 ins. - marked R. on E. side - 45 links N.E. from Cor. to Sect. 8, 9, 16 & 17 T. 3 N. R. 33 E. and from said Cor. Iron along line, bet. said sections 9 & 16, 80.00 chs. Set sawed fir post 4x4x42 ins. marked IM on N. side - about 45 links S. of R. l. c. (road center) 80.00 chs. along line bet. sec. 10 & 15 in same sp. Set sawed fir post 4x4x42 ins. - marked IIM on N. side - about 45 links S. of R. l. c. near residence of Gideon Long. 80.00 chs. along traveled road on line bet. Sect. 10 & 14 Set sawed fir post 4x4x42 ins. - marked IIIM on N. side - about 35 links S. of R. l. c. 80.00 chs. along line bet. Sect. 12 & 13 in T. 3 N. R. 33 E. Set sawed fir post 4x4x42 ins. marked IVM on N. side about 30 lks. S. of R. l. c. * 28.50 chs. along line bet. Sect. 7 & 18 in T. 3 N. R. 34 E. Set A.S. (angle stake) 30 lks S. of R. l. c. S. 35° 30' E. 27.50 chs. cross Greasewood - Set A.S. 30 lks. S. of R. l. c. N. 43° 50' E. 32.00 chs. slight ascent - Set A.S. 30 lks. S. of R. l. c. East 37.10 chs. along line bet said sec. 7 & 18 - 1/4 S. cor. bet. same - Set A.S. 50 lks to S.W. South 53.00 ch along line N. & S. through center Sec. 18. Set A.S. at R. l. c. East 76.83 ch W. line of Town Site - Eastland, at a point, the center of W. end of 3^d. street.

East 80.00 chs. along center said 3" street
 Set saved fir $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4 \times 42$ ins marked VM, at R. C.
 4.60 chs Center Chestnut Street in said town;
 Set A. S. at R. C.

South 12.88 chs. descending along center of said Chestnut St
 to R. R. Depot Grounds.
 Set saved fir post $4 \times 4 \times 42$ marked R.
 at R. C. for terminus
 All the posts were set in mounds as required
 by law. The road is plainly marked by
 fencing or by travel throughout.
