Now on this day it is ordered by the Court that the petition  
of E. J. Straughlin et al praying for a County Road, be and the same  
is hereby denied for the reason of indefinite description of location.

In the matter of the County Road. }  
Commencing at a point at the South West Corner of } Road # 521  
the South East quarter of section seven in Township  
three North Range 33 E. W. M. Umatilla County State of Oregon of Oregon  
running thence due west on the section line between said  
section seven and section eighteen same township  
and Range to a point at the South West corner  
of the South East quarter of section seven and to a  
location that certain road now established commencing  
running and terminating as follows to wit commencing  
at a point at the southwest corner of the Southeast quarter  
of section seven in Township three North Range  
thirty three East of Willamette Meridian Umatilla  
County Oregon running thence due south along the  
centerline through section 18 same Township  
and range to the south end of said center line  
through said section eighteen

Now on this day comes the report of the Viewers  
W. D. Barnard, J. Barnhart and B. F. Renn heretofore  
appointed at the January 1901 Term of the Court, to view out and  
report upon the location of the above road as a County road  
for final hearing, the same having been read upon a previous  
day of this term of this Court to wit the March 1901 Term and

The said Viewers having reported favorably and Recommended the establishing of the Same as a County Road, and the field notes and plat of Survey, being duly on file and certified to by the Surveyor, appointed to survey the Same, it is therefore ordered, that the report of Viewers be and the same as accepted,

and there being no remonstrances on file against said road.

It is therefore **Ordered** that said **road** be established as a **County road** in accordance with the report of said viewers and that the said field notes and plat of Survey, thereof be recorded as required by law, and the supervisor through whose district said road runs be directed to open the same for public use, as a County Road,

In the matter of County road \* 522 Commencing at North west corner of the Northeast quarter of section thirty five in Township Five north of range thirty five East of the Willamette Meridian, and running in a southeasterly direction along <sup>the</sup> present traveled road, until it intersects Oregon Railway and Navigation Company's right of way, thence westerly crossing said right of way, at right angles, thence to the Western line thereof, thence in a southeasterly direction following the road as now travelled, to its intersection with the Township line between Township Four and Five, in Range thirty-five East of the Willamette Meridian
