In the matter of Locating, establishing, changing and widening of a county road same being designated and commonly known as the Sax Hill Road.

RESOLUTION

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN, Greetings,
WHEREAS there now exists in Umatilla County, State of Oregon, what is known as the SAX HILL road, the same being a County Road and Highway in the aforesaid county and state, and

WHEREAS, this being a regular term of the above entitled Court, now in regular session and sitting for the transaction of County Business, with all members of said court present;

NOW, therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Court of Umatilla County, State of Oregon, that it is, and is hereby declared to be the intention of the said County Court, to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten, and change a highway or road on and over a route as follows:

A strip of land in the Southwest quarter of Section 20, township 3 North Range 33 E.W.M., more particularly described as follows:
Beginning at a point 720.0 feet North and 20.0 feet West of the quarter section corner common to sections 20 and 29, township 3 North Range 33 E.W.M. thence south 240.4 feet; thence South 23 degrees 20' West 0.00 feet; thence on a curve to the right of radius 603.0 feet a distance of 126.6 feet; thence South 35 degrees 32' West 287.4 feet; thence on a curve to the left of radius 543.0 feet a distance of 143.3 feet; thence West 63.8 feet; thence North 18 degrees 18' East 0.00 feet; thence on a curve to the right of radius 603.0 feet a distance of 181.4 feet; thence North 35 degrees 32' West 287.4 feet; thence on a curve to the left of radius 543.0 feet a distance of 337.7 feet; thence East 10.0 feet to the place of beginning containing 0.93 acres more or less,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a public necessity for said Road or Highway is hereby declared to exist for the following reasons, to-wit:

To straighten and eliminate the curves, to effect a suitable grade, and for the purpose of accommodating motor traffic, it is essential that the road be constructed over and across the lands hereinbefore described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Attorney of Umatilla County, State of Oregon, be, and he is hereby requested and directed to bring such condemnation proceedings as may be necessary to condemn the said property as by law provided, for the purposes hereinbefore referred to, and that a true copy of this resolution be duly entered in the Commissioner's journal of said Court.

Done and dated in Open Court this 17th day of April, A.D., 1928.

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In the matter of Issuing a Deed to Dick & Alice A. Powers for Lot 5, Block 8, Weston, Umatilla County, Oregon

Now on this day comes Dick and Alice A. Powers, and tender to Umatilla County the sum of \$100.00 to cover back taxes on Lot 5, Block 8, Weston, Umatilla County, Oregon. And it duly appearing to the Court that said land has been bid in by Umatilla County for taxes, the total amount required to redeem the same is \$100.00, and that said Dick and Alice A. Powers are the former owners of said parcel of land.

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED by the court that for and in consideration of the sum of \$100.00, a good and sufficient deed of Conveyance shall be made by this court to Dick and Alice A. Powers for lot 5, Block 8, Weston, Umatilla County, Oregon.
