ROAD NOTICE

TO ALL PERSONS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County, by the Undersigned, who are freeholders of said County and State, and reside in the road district or districts of the hereinafter described route for a County road, at the **November** 1921 term, of said County Court, to-wit: On the ^{5th} day of **Nov**, 19**21**

praying said Court to lay out, locate and establish a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit:

At a 120 penny spike driven in the ground 20 ft, from the center of the Wild Horse pavement and S 54°-43'W--1552 ft, from the 1/4 section Corner on the east of section I, Tp. 2N R. 32 E., thence running N 87°-45'E--335 ft; thence S 75°-15'E--338 ft; thence Due South 1010 ft, to the center of Riverside ~~Drive~~ ^{Avenue} at the center of the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section I, Tp. 2N. R. 32 E. W. M.

(Above mentioned 1010 ft. now a private lane 30 ft. wide; additional 10 ft. needed to be taken from adjoining property on West side of said lane).

Said road to be Forty feet wide.
