PETITION.

TO THE COUNTY COURT OF UMATILLA COUNTY:

We, the undersigned, your petitioners, respectfully pray
this Honorable Court to lay out, locate and cause to be opened
a county road as follows:

Beginning at a point where the county road known as the
Cold Spring road leading from Cold Spring to Pendleton, in Umatilla
County, State of Oregon, reaches a point where the half
section line running East and West in sections 25 and 26 in-
tersects the section line running North and South between sections
25 and 26; thence running south along the section line between
sections 25 and 26 and sections 35 and 36 in township 3 North
range 32 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County,
State of Oregon, one mile; thence running West one-half mile to a
point where the half section lines running East and West and North
and South divide section 35 in township 3 North range 32 East of
the Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, State of Oregon;
thence south 40 rods to a stake firmly set in the ground, marked
"R"; thence West 59 rods to a stake firmly set in the ground marked
"R"; thence southwesterly 35 rods to a point on the road leading
to Lee Street Bridge and intersecting said road, which point is
designated and marked by a stake firmly set in the ground marked
"R", and your petitioners will ever pray.
