

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned will on Thursday, the 6th day of July, 1899, at the court-house in the City of Pendleton, Umatilla County, Oregon, at the hour of ten o'clock A.M. petition and apply to the County Court of Umatilla County, State of Oregon, to have a county road located, laid out and opened in Umatilla County, State of Oregon, as follows:

Beginning at a point where the county road known as the Cold Spring road leading from Cold Spring to Pendleton, in Umatilla County, State of Oregon, reaches a point where the half section line running East and West in sections 25 and 26 intersects the section line running North and South between sections 25 and 26; thence running south along the section line between sections 25 and 26 and sections 35 and 36 in township 3 North range 32 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, State of Oregon, one mile; thence running West one-half mile to a point where the half section lines running East and West and North and South divide section 35 in township 3 North range 32 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, State of Oregon; thence south 40 rods to a stake firmly set in the ground, marked "R"; thence West 59 rods to a stake firmly set in the ground marked "R"; thence southwesterly 35 rods to a point on the road leading to Lee Street Bridge and intersecting said road, which point is designated and marked by a stake firmly set in the ground marked "R".
