

FIELD NOTES OF COUNTY ROAD NO. 740.

I commence at a point 660 ft. north of the S. E. corner of Sec. 1, T. 2 N., R. 32 E., W. M. At a point 20 ft. north of aforesaid point I set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, marked R. 740: dug pits, 18 X 18 X 12 ins., S. & W. of post, and raised mound of earth, 18 ins. high, 4 ft. base, around post.

Thence west along the center of a present traveled road 3058 ft. to a County road at a point 690 ft. southeasterly from the center of the south half of said section 1, a point from which I set, 30 ft. S. & 20 ft. E. a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, marked R. T. 740: dug pits E. & W. of post, and raised mound of earth, 18 ins. high, 4 ft. base, around post.

I hereby certify that the foregoing field notes of County road No. 740 are correct, according to survey made by me on the 23'd day of July 1912.
