IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR UMATILLA COUNTY.

In the matter of opening County Road No. 671, petitioned for by Mary Paulsen et al.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the June 1909, term of this Court to view, survey stake and layout said road No 671, as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter Section 21 Tp 1 N.R 34 E.W.M., running thence West one-half mile more or less, to the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 21 aforesaid, thence running North along the most practical route to the Northeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 16, in Tp. 1 North Range 34 E.W.M., where it intersects the established County road running east and west through said point. and to be 40 feet wide, as a County Road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on July 8th, 1909, and publicly read the second time on July 9th, 1909, and the said Board of County Road Viewers, having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of said road as a County Road, and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to, survey the same, and it appearing to the Court that said road would be of sufficient public utility, and there being no remonstrance or objections filed to said report, and it duly appearing to the Court that all matters are regular, it is hereby ORDERED, that said report of the Board of County Road Viewers be accepted and that the plat and field notes be recorded in the records of plats and field notes of Umatilla County, and that the Road Master of Umatilla County be and he is hereby ordered to open said road for public use.
