ROAD NOTICE.

TO ALL PERSONS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County, by the Undersigned who are freeholders of said County and State and reside in the road district or districts of the hereinafter described route for a County road, at the December term, A.D. 1907, of said County Court, to-wit: On the 7th day of December 1907, praying said Court to lay out, locate and establish a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the point in the center of County Road No. 578 of Umatilla County, Oregon, where said road crosses the East line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 17, in Township 1 North of Range 34 East of the Willamette Meridian, at which point is placed a large stone, the same being about 12 feet North of the Southeast corner of said Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 17; thence running Northwesterly and along the most practicable route for a road, a distance of 200 feet to a mound of stone with a stake standing in the center thereof; thence running Northeasterly and

Said road to be 60 feet wide.
