Kenison the Viewers heretofore appointed at the July term 1892 of this Court to view and determine how much less valuable the land of John Morrison would be rendered by reason of the location of the above mentioned road as a County road for final hearing the same having been filed on Sept 6. 1892 it appearing from said report that said Viewers met at the time and place appointed and were duly qualified before entering upon the discharge of their duties in his behalf. and it further appearing from said report that said Viewers have estimated and appraised the damages sustained to the land of John Morrison at the sum of \$250<sup>00</sup> and it also appearing to the Court that the Viewers heretofore appointed to view and report upon the location of the above mentioned road duly made their report at the July term 1892 of this Court and that said Viewers reported favorably and recommend the the location of the same as a County road and the report of said Viewers, field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required upon payment by the petitioners herein to said John Morrison or his attorney the sum of two hundred and fifty Dollars, as awarded him as damages by the said Viewers B. F. Martin, J. S. Todd and G. F. Kenison and the satisfaction of said sum having been paid to be filed with the Clerk of this Court by the petitioners herein. and that upon said satisfaction of the payment of said damages being filed as ordered, the Road supervisor through whose district said road runs be directed to open the same to Public use as a County road.

Now there being no further business coming before the Court and the Journal having been read approved and signed whereupon Court adjourned until tomorrow morning at 9 O'Clock am
