

BE IT REMEMBERED, that at a regular term of the County Court of the State of Oregon, for the County of Umatilla, begun and held on the County Court House in Pendleton, in said County and State, on Wednesday the 3rd. day of May A.D. 1905, the same being the first Wednesday in said month and the time fixed by law for holding a regular term of said Court.

WHEREUPON, a term of said Court is begun and holden on the 9th day of May 1905, the same being the 6 Judicial day of said Court, and among other proceedings, the following were had to-wit:-

In the matter of opening County road No. 569 Deeded by John McQuowen and wife and E. N. Smith and wife, commencing running and terminating as follows: Commencing at the North east corner of the Southeast quarter of Sec. 24 Tp. 1 North Range 32 E. W. M. and run thence West along 1/4 Section line to the center of said Section 24, thence South 40 feet, thence East to the East line of said Section 24, thence North 40 feet to the place of beginning. also beginning at the center of said Section 24, run thence West one half mile to the West line of said Section 24, thence South 30 feet thence East one half mile to the line ~~to be line~~ running North and South through the center of said Section 24, thence North 30 feet to the place of beginning.

Now on this day comes the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the March 1905 term of this Court to view, layout, and report upon said proposed road No. 569 commencing at the Northeast corner of Southeast quarter of Section 24 in Tp/1 North Range 32 E. W. M. and run thence West along 1/4 Section line to the center of said Section 24, thence South 40 feet, thence East to the East line of said Section 24 thence North 40 feet to the place of beginning.:

also beginning at the center of said Section 24 thence South 30 feet thence East one half mile to the line running North and South through the center of said Section 24, thence North 30 feet to the place of beg.

as a County road for final hearing, the same having been ^{publicly} read on two different days of this Term of Court, the first time on May 3, 1905, and publicly read the second time on May 4th. 1905, and the said board of County road viewers having reported favorably, and recommended the opening of said road as a County road, and the field notes and the plat

of survey being on file, and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same, and all files and records herein having been submitted to the District Attorney for said County, and the same having been approved by him, and the Court being satisfied that said road will be of public utility, it is,

THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED, by the Court, that the report of Board of County road Viewers, be accepted, and that said report, survey, profile, and plats be recorded in full in the record of plats and field notes for said County, and said road be opened as a County road in accordance with the report of said viewers, and that the Road Supervisor through whose district said road runs, be directed to open the same for public use.
