Whereas, it is desired by the Umatilla County Court and the Umatilla County Road Department to vacate a portion of the old County Road No. 915 near the following described reconstructed and relocated portion of said County Road No. 915 which lies outside the said described reconstructed and relocated portion of said County Road No. 915, as per the terms of ORS 368.540, to wit:

Beginning at a point on the Northeasterly line of County Road No. 915 at its intersection with the North-South centerline of Section 15, Township 2

North, Range 32 East of Willamette Meridian, and running thence North 332 feet more or less to the point where the old location of said road curved in a Northwesterly direction away from the said North-South centerline, excluding therefrom, all portions which remain on the existing paved road right-of-way, and

Whereas, the Umatilla County Court and Umatilla County Road Department no longer considers the above described portion of said County Road No. 915 to be useful part of the Umatilla County Road Department roads network or to the general public, and

Whereas, the public will be benefited if the portion of said County Road No. 915 is vacated because said portion of road is dangerous and burdensome to maintain, and has been replaced by another road,

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that proceedings to vacate said portions of said County Road No. 915 be undertaken, and that the Umatilla County Engineer is hereby ordered to examine said road and make a report in writing on the same, and said written report is to be filed in the office of the County Clerk of Umatilla County, State of Oregon.
