O R D E R

Now on this day this matter coming on before the County Court of Umatilla County, Oregon, sitting for the transaction of County Business, for Final Hearing, and it appearing to the Court that a Resolution was adopted on the 30th day of December, 1938, by this Court, declaring its intention to locate, establish, alter, widen straighten and change a road or highway on and over the hereinafter, described route, said road or highway to be a strip of land 60 feet wide and lying in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec 10 and the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 15 Township 2, N.R. 32 E. W. M. as County Road No. 915 and known as the Tutuilla Road.

This road was established for many years but the field notes and papers in regard to road cannot be found and in order that the location of the road can be defined it has been necessary to resurvey said road.

It further appearing to the Court that true copies of the said resolution herein were certified to as such by the Clerk of this court, and were posted by the County Surveyor, Frank Hayes, as provided by law, thirty days prior to February 1, 1939.

And it further appearing to the Court that no objections or remonstrances have been presented or filed herein, and that no person or persons have appeared adversely hereto,

It is therefore ORDERED that said road be finally surveyed and opened and that the field notes be recorded in the records kept for that purpose in the office of the County Surveyor of Umatilla County, Oregon, and from and after the date of this ORDER said road shall be and the same is hereby declared to be a Public Highway.
