ROAD NOTICE.

TO ALL PERSONS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County, by the Undersigned who are freeholders of said County and State and reside in the road district or districts of the hereinafter described route for a County road, at the May term, of said County Court, to-wit: On the 6th day of May, 1908, 1

praying said Court to lay out, locate and establish a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit:.....

Commencing at the center of county road No. 3, leading from Pendleton to Pilot Rock, at a point where the termination of Alma street in the Town of Pilot Rock intersects said county road No. 3 on the section line between sections 16 and 17, Tp. 1 S.R. 32 E.W.M.; thence south on the section line between said sections 16 and 17 to intersection of rock bluff on the south side of said town of Pilot Rock; thence southeasterly, on or near the present traveled road, to the line fence between Sturdivant's land and Etter's land in said Sec. 16; thence due south to the corner of said Etter's land; thence east on line between said Etter and Sturdivant about forty rods; thence southeasterly up what is known as Scott's Gulch on the right hand side thereof through the lands of Sturdivant, Belts and A.C. Henderson & Son to intersection of line between said Henderson & Son and A. B. Noble; thence across said gulch on or about the said last named line; thence continuing on the left hand side of said gulch through the lands of Boble and Scott to intersect the old traveled road at or near the east line of the Scott lands.

Said road to be forty feet wide, except that portion along the east side of Pilot Rock, known as Bluff St., shall be 60 feet wide.
