In the Matter of Report of Viewers of Road No. 565.)

Now on this day comes the report of the Board of County road viewers for road No. 565, heretofore directed to view out and report on the location of the above road as a County road, the same having been read the first time January 6th, 1905, and read the second time January 11th, 1905, and the said report being favorable and it appearing to the Court that said road would be of sufficient public utility, It is ORDERED that said road be and the same is hereby accepted and approved, and that said road and field notes be recorded and platted as a county road.

In the Matter of the Claim of Carney & Kennedy.)

Now on this day comes the claim of Carney & Kennedy, of \$2.50 livery hire, by John W Kimbrell, on account of Road No. 565, and it appearing to the Court that this claim is allowed to Surveyor and Viewers in the way of mileage, it is HEREBY ORDERED that the claim of Carney & Kennedy be, and the same is hereby disallowed.

In the Matter of the Sheriff's bi-monthly Statement of T D Taylor, for the months of November and December, 1904.)

Now on this day comes T D Taylor, Sheriff of Umatilla County, and presents to the Court his bi-monthly statement of fees and taxes collected for the months of November and December, 1904, showing mileage fees collected for that period, amounting to \$90.10; Taxes, including Sheriff's assessments, penalties and interest, amounting to \$1877.44, and tax redemption to the amount of \$65.65; advertising tax sales, \$8.15. And the Court having examined the same and found it in all things correct, it is hereby ORDERED that the same be and it is hereby in all things approved.

In the Matter of opening County road deeded to Umatilla County.)

Now, on this day it appearing to the Court that a road was deeded to Umatilla County by Howard C Dunn and Edith Dunn, his wife, H A Faxon and Bessie R Faxon, his wife; beginning at a point on the Long Creek road 100 rods North of the southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter, Section 27, Township 2 North, range 32, E W M; running thence due west about 150 rods to intersect with the County Road No. 482, and that said deeded road was accepted by the County Court as a public road and has not yet been opened to travel. It is THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED that S K Yates, road supervisor of MCKay District, be and he is hereby ORDERED and directed to open said road to travel as a public road. And the Court being of the opinion that said road is of sufficient importance to the public to cause the damages to be paid by the County, it is therefore HEREBY ORDERED that the damages assessed by the Board of County road Viewers be paid out of the County treasury of Umatilla County, to-wit: The sum of \$15.00 assessed to H A Faxon, and the sum of \$15.00 assessed to H C Dunn, and the Clerk is ORDERED to draw a warrant for the said amounts.
