

In the letter of the petition of P. E. WARD, et al for the vacating of County Road commencing at the S.W. corner of the S.E. 1/4, Section 12, Tp. 3, R.R. 22, N.W. 1/4.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard

this being the time and term for final decision of the Court and it

appearing that due and lawful advertising of the final hearing herein has been given by posting notices thereof at the place of holding this

Court and in the vicinity of the petition

of said road as proposed to be vacated and more than thirty days before

the date of the hearing and that proper notice

has been given to the parties to the petition

and that the petition is now ready for the Court to

decide thereon and it appearing that said petition

will be benefited by the proposed vacation, and that of sufficient

public benefit so warrant vacation by the Court,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DECREED that the following portion

of said road in Washington County, Oregon, to-wit: commencing at the

S.W. corner of the S.E. 1/4 of Section 12, Tp. 3, R.R. 22, N.W. 1/4, thence

southward one mile through the center of said section 12, thence

westward along the line dividing sections 1, 12, 13, and 14 of the said

township and thence terminating at the S.W. corner of S.E. quarter

of Section 2, Township 3, R.R. 22, N.W. 1/4, be vacated and hereinafter to

be maintained, is of no value for any other use, is unnecessary and expensive

to maintain, and its vacation as a part of the general road system and the

public will be benefited by the vacation

of said road.
