WE THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are freeholders of said Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the road district, or districts where said road is to be laid out, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located, and established a County Road in said County and State. commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point where the section lines between sections seventeen (17) and twenty (20) in Tp. four (4) N. R. twenty eight (28) E. W. M. intersects the east boundary line of the Umatilla River, thence east along section lines as nearly as practicable to the north east (N.E) corner of section twenty four (24) of said Tp. four (4) there intersecting the east boundary line of said Tp. four (4) and there terminating.

Said road to be Sixty Six feet wide.

And your petitioners will ever pray.
