Now on this day this matter coming on for consideration upon the report of the board of county road viewers heretofore appointed at the August term of this court to view and report upon the opening of said road petitioned for as follows:

Commencing at the NW cor of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4 T 4 N R 28 E W M and running thence east as near as practicable on the quarter section line through sections 4, 3, 2 and 1, to the N E cor of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 1 in said township and range.

And it appearing to the court that the said board of county road viewers has reported favorably upon said road and recommended that this court establish the same as a county road, and it further appearing to the court that a petition signed by more than 12 freeholders and signers of the original has been presented asking that said road be made forty feet wide, and the court being advised,

It is now therefore ordered that said road be and the same is hereby established as a county road to be forty feet in width, and that the report of said board of viewers be and the same is hereby accepted and ordered placed of record, and the road master of Umatilla county is hereby ordered to open said road for public use.
