

FIELD NOTES OF ROAD NO. 699.

I commence at the southeast corner of the S. W. 1/4 of section 32 T. 5 N., R. 29 E., W. M. At a point 33 ft. N. and 20 ft. E. of said corner I set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, marked R. No. 699; dug pits, 18 X 18 X 12 ins., E. and S. of post, and raised mound of earth, 18 ins. high, 4 ft. base, around post.

Thence, following the subdivisinal section line, I run north 51.29 Chs. to irrigation ditch 12 ft. wide, course N. E.

79.84 Chs. the north east corner of the N. W. 1/4 of said section 32 in said township and range, ~~where~~ *at a point 30 ft. S. and 20 ft. E. of said corner* I set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, marked R. T. No. 699; dug pits S. and E. of post, and raised a mound of earth, 18 ins. high, 4 ft. base, around post.

I hereby certify that the foregoing field notes of road No. 699 are correct as surveyed by me on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of Feb. 1911.
