RIGHT OF WAY DEED.

IN THE MATTER OF OREGON ROAD, known as the Old Oregon Trail Highway

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Clarence Tilden & Carrie L Tilden, his wife John Morgan & Rena Morgan, his wife, James Williams & Bertha Williams, his wife, Henry Rogers and Georgia Rogers, his wife, M. Abplanalp and and Mary Abplanalp, his wife, of the County of Umatilla in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One Dollars, paid them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situated in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit:

A strip of land ___ feet wide being ___ feet on ___ side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of of Section 10, Township 4 North Range 29 W.M.

Beginning at station 562 plus 05.6 of the Old Oregon Trail Highway Survey which station is the intersection of the extended center line of First Street in the City of Hermiston and the East and West $\frac{1}{4}$ line through Section 10 T. 4 N., R. 28 E.W.M., which station is approximately 620 feet west of the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner between section 10 and 11 T. 4 N., R 28 E.W.M.; thence East along $\frac{1}{4}$ line through section 10 T. 4 N., R. 28 E.W.M. 26.3 feet; thence N. 23 degrees 59 minutes W. 1325 feet; thence N. 26 degrees 19 minutes west 189.6 feet; thence N. 27 degrees 29 minutes West 117.0 feet; thence N. 28 degrees 24 minutes West 82.2 feet thence N. 29 degrees 45 minutes West 100.1 feet; thence South 24 degrees 51 minutes East 120.0 feet; thence South 22 degrees 41 minutes East 1677.8 feet parallel and 25 feet West of the center line of the Old Oregon Trail Highway as surveyed and staked upon the ground; thence East along said $\frac{1}{4}$ line through section 10, 26.3 feet to the place of beginning containing 1.36 acres, more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
