WHEREAS, It appears that vacation of a portion of Quincy Avenue, County Road No. 1277, would be beneficial to the Public because a large portion of the road as described in Book 246 Page 162, Deed Records, now contains landscaping and other improvements, much of the traveled road to the river lies outside of the recorded right-of-way, and vacation of the road would not affect public access to the Columbia River, as it would remain public (Corps of Engineers) property.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, in accordance with ORS 368.326 to 368.366, that proceedings be undertaken to vacate that portion of County Road No. 1277 described as: A permanent 80 foot wide easement and right-of-way granted by Cyril and Florence Brownell and Zella and Ralph Joder to Umatilla County, recorded in Book 246, Page 162, Umatilla County Deed Records, and more particularly described as the Westerly 40' of Lot D and the Easterly 40' of Lot C, McNary Addition Plat. The legal description of adjacent property is Lot C and Lot D, McNary Addition, both owned by the Army Corps of Engineers and leased by Umatilla Marina.


IT IS ORDERED that the Director, Department of Public Works, examine said road and file a written report pursuant to ORS 368.346(1).


