ORDER

THIS MATTER coming on for hearing before the County Court of Umatilla County on this 18th day of May, 1973, and

IT APPEARING that the Port of Umatilla has heretofore conveyed to Umatilla County by Dedication Deed, a certain road and that it would be in the best interests of the public if that road were accepted, established, and thereafter maintained as a County road and serve as a useful part of the road system of this County, and

IT ALSO APPEARING that pursuant to statute a hearing was scheduled advising any and all persons interested or having objections thereto, and further advising that it was the County Court's intention to so make, establish, and declare this same road to be a county road; that a hearing having been scheduled for this same day and notice thereof having been duly made by posting true copies of this Court's Resolution of Intent, certified by the County Clerk, and

IT FURTHER APPEARING that upon the hearing of this matter there were no objections thereto, now therefore, it is the

ORDER of this Court that the following described parcel constituting a right-of-way 60 feet in width, lying 30 feet on either side of a center line, and more particularly described as:

Commencing at the Section corner common to Sections 11, 12, 13, and 14, Township 5 North, Range 28 East, W.M. and running thence South 0°28'30" West a distance of 3810.22 feet to a point on the center line of U. S. Highway 730 as it existed on November 21, 1972, said point also lying 40 feet Westerly when measured at right angles to the East line of said Section 14, said point also being the true point of beginning for this description; thence North 0°10'05" West a distance of 4680.11 feet; thence Northwesterly along a 409.70 foot radius curve to the left, the chord bears North 49°54'50" West 626.90 feet, a distance of 711.44 feet; thence South 80°20'20" West a distance of 2670.74 feet; thence Northwesterly along a 477.47 foot radius curve to the right, the chord bears North 82°05'40" West 288.22 feet, a distance of 292.78 feet; thence North 64°31'40" West a distance of 1098.85 feet; thence Northerly along a 163.70 foot radius curve to the right, the chord bears North 2°16'40" West 289.74 feet, a distance of 355.70 feet; thence North 59°58'20" East a distance of 204.95 feet to the hereinafter mentioned Point A.

Also a parcel of land lying in Section 11, Township 5 North, Range 28 East, W.M. described as follows:

Beginning at the above mentioned point "A", said point being North 67°56'50" West a distance of 4605.03 feet from the Southeast corner of said Section 11; thence North 30°01'40" West 40.00 feet; thence North 59°58'20" East 43.41 feet; thence North 16°18'20" West 72.50 feet; thence North 73°41'50" East 245.70 feet; thence South 16°18'20" East 62.50 feet; thence South 73°41'50" West 40.00 feet; thence South 27°28'00" West 113.38 feet; thence South 59°58'20" West 150.00 feet; thence North 30°01'40" West 60.00 feet to the point of beginning.

All being in the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, and

The same is hereby declared to be ACCEPTED and ESTABLISHED as a County Road, and it is SO ORDERED.
