WHEREAS, the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners deem it as in the best interest of the County to transfer that portion of County Road 1303 from its intersection with State Highway 395 to the intersection with County Road 1320; and


WHEREAS, it appears that on October 4, 1994, the City of Pendleton, through its City Council and Mayor, agreed to accept jurisdiction over this portion of Southgate Place that meets City construction requirements; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the Board of Commissioners held a public hearing on July 27, 1994, at 10:15 a.m. in Room 114 of the Umatilla County Courthouse, Pendleton, Oregon; that notice of the hearing was given as provided by law; that all public testimony was fully considered and that the Board of Commissioners found it in the public interest to transfer jurisdiction over Southgate Place, as described above, to the City of Pendleton.

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that Umatilla County hereby offers to the City of Pendleton jurisdiction over the above described portion of County Road 1303. The City of Pendleton, in accordance with an Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and the County, is hereby requested to accept the County's offer at the City's earliest municipal legislative hearing.
