Now on this day comes the report of Jacob Frazer, James M. Hemphill and Burr Johnson the viewers heretofore appointed at the April 1886 Term of this Court to view and determine how much less valuable the lands of Josiah Clore would be rendered by reason of the location of the above mentioned road as a County Road for final hearing, the same having been read on a previous day of this Term of this Court to wit July 1886 Term and it appearing from said report that said viewers duly met at the time and place appointed and were duly qualified before entering upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf, and it further appearing from said report that the said viewers have estimated and appraised the damage sustained to the land of Josiah Clore at the sum of \$125-

It is therefore ordered by the Court that upon payment by the petitioners herein to Josiah Clore or the Clerk of this Court the sum of \$125, as awarded him as damages by the said viewers Jacob Frazer, James M. Hemphill and Burr Johnson and the satisfaction of said sum having been paid, to be filed with the Clerk of this Court by the petitioners herein.

And that upon said satisfaction of the payment of said damages being filed as ordered, the Road Supervisors through whose District said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road.
