Now on this day comes the report of T. B. Wells and J. S. McLeod viewers heretofore appointed at the Sept term 1890 of this Court to view and determine how much less valuable the lands of J. P. Whittemore would be rendered by reason of the location of the above mentioned road as a County Road for final hearing the same having been read on a previous day of this term of this Court to-wit Nov. 1890 and it duly appearing from said report that said views met at the place and time

appointed, and duly qualified according to law and it further appearing from said report that said viewers have estimated the damages to the land of J. P. Whittemore to be \$75⁰⁰

And it also appearing to the Court that the viewers heretofore appointed to view out and upon the location of the above mentioned road duly made their report at the Sept. term 1890 of this Court that said viewers reported favorably and recommended the location of the above mentioned road as a County road, and the field notes and plat of survey of said road being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the report of said viewers be accepted and that the road be established in accordance with said report and the report of said viewers, field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required upon payment by the petitioner herein to said J. P. Whittemore or his attorney \$75⁰⁰ as awarded him as damages by the said viewers T. B. Wells and J. S. McLeod and the satisfaction of said sum having been paid to be filed with the clerk of this Court by the petitioner herein.

And upon said satisfaction of the payment of said damages being filed as ordered the road supervisors through whose districts said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road.
