

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County :

We, the undersigned your petitioners, who are residents and householders in Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located and established, a County road in said County and State commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit :

Commencing at the initial Post in Road Survey No. 342, which is a sawed fir 4 ins. sq. marked M1 on W. face & R on S. face, near head of grade, on W. side of lower crossing of McKay Creek, in S.E. cor. of Sec 20, T. 2, N. R. 32, E. Following said Road Survey, No. 342, thence to its intersection with the line bet. Secs. 29 & 32, in said Twp; thence, up a certain Ravine, to intersect the line bet. Secs. 5 & 6 in S. 1, N. R. 32, E., at a point about 150 yds. S. of cor. to Secs. 5, 6, 31 & 32. Thence S. along S. E. line, to the S. E. cor. bet. said Secs. 5 & 6, thence W. to intersect said Road Survey No. 342, thence along said Survey No. 342, as near as may be for the best Road, to its terminus; thence continuing up Comb's Cañon, on best route to scale wall, thence up the N. Fork of Comb's Cañon, on best route to int. line bet. Ranges 30 & 31, E. W. and

Said road to be 60 ft wide excepting at ^{feet wide} crossing of Birch Creek 40 ft

And your petitioners will ever pray.
