

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR
UMATILLA COUNTY.

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are residents and householders in Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, respectfully petition your Honorable Body to cause to be laid out, located and established, a County road in said county and state, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point in the center of Road No. 397, known as the McKay Creek Road, on the North line of the South West quarter of section 27, Township 2 North Range 32 East Willamette meridian, 230 links East of the Northwest corner of said Southwest quarter; thence running South 5 degrees East 14.55 chains; thence West 3.25 chains to the Section line between Sections 27 and 28, Township and Range aforesaid; thence South along said Section line 19.93 chains; thence South 65 degrees West 3.75 chains, across McKay Creek; thence in a Southwesterly direction upon the most practicable route over the East half of the East half of Section 33, said Township and Range, and up the gulch to intersect road No. 147 running from Pendleton to Pilot Rock, on the ridge near the Southeast corner of said Section 33; thence in a Southwesterly direction on the most practicable route to Lee's Crossing on Birch creek, in Section 4 Township 1 North of Range 32 East Willamette Meridian; thence across said Creek at said crossing, along the most practicable route, in a Southwesterly direction, to the center of said section 4, Township and Range aforesaid. Said road to be 40 feet wide.
