

BE IT REMEMBERED, that a regular term of the County Court of the State of Oregon, for the County of Umatilla, is begun and held in the County Court House in Pendleton, in said County and State, on Wednesday the 2d day of May A.D. 1906, the same being the first Wednesday in said month and the time fixed by law for holding a regular term of said Court.

WHEREUPON, a term of said Court is begun and holden on Friday the 4th day of May 1906, the same being the 3d judicial day of said term and among other ~~the~~ proceedings the following were had to-wit:

Now on this day comes the report of the Board of County road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the January Term 1906 of this Court, to view, layout and report upon said proposed County Road No. ~~580~~ 580, commencing at the County road at the Southeast cor. of Section 8 Tp. 3 North Range 28 E.W.M.; run thence North One mile between Section 8 and 9 said Tp and Range; thence East 1/2 mile between Section 9 and 4 in said Tp. and Range; thence North 2 miles through the center of Section 4 Tp. 3 North range 28 E.W.M, and through the center of Section 33 Tp. 4 North Range 28 E.W.M. to the Umatilla river; thence in a Northwesterly direction along the said Umatilla river about 200 yards more or less to the Butter Creek Bridge over the Umatilla River in Township 4 North, Range 28 E.W.M, as a county road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of court being publicly read the first time on March 8, 1906, and publicly read the second time on March 12, 1906, this matter having been continued at the March 1906 term of this court until the present date, and the said Board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended the opening of said road as a county road, and the field notes and plat of survey being on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same and there being a claim to-wit: to the amount of ~~2000~~ \$2000 for a considerable amount of damages for that portion of said road

as petitioned for in Section 28, Township 4 North, Range 28, and the Court being satisfied that said portion of said road would not be of ^{great} public utility and the petitioners through W B Hamilton having filed their consent to the opening of said road from the beginning point of said road to the center of Section 33, Township 4 North, Range 28 EWM, and the Court being ^{as hereinafter Ordered to be opened} satisfied that said road will be of public utility.

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED by the Court that the report of Board of County Road Viewers be ^{except as to that part as above mentioned} accepted and that said report, survey profile and plat be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of said county, and that said road be opened as a county road in accordance with a report of said viewers as follows to-wit:
COMMENCING at the County road at the Southeast corner of Section 8 Township 3 North, Range 28 EWM, run thence North 1 mile between Sections 8 and 9 said Tp and Range, thence East 1/2 mile between Sections 9 and 4 in said Tp and Range, thence North 1-1/2 miles to the center of Section 33, Tp ⁴ North, Range 28 EWM, and that the road supervisor through whose district said road runs be directed to open the same for public use.
