Near Mr Lees Residence on Birch Creek
to head of Union Canyon

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers appointed by this Court to view out and locate & report upon the establishment of a County Road above mentioned for final hearing & reading the same having been read on a previous day of this Term of this Court to wit July 5th 1881 and the viewers having reported favorably upon the location of said Road and recommended the Establishment of the same as a County Road and the field notes and plat of survey having been duly filed & certified by the surveyor appointed by this Court to survey the same

It is therefore Ordered by the Court that said Road be established as a County Road in accordance with the prayer of the said Petitioners and the report of the viewers herein, and that said report of viewers field notes and plat of Survey be recorded as by law required

In the Matter of County Road from
Crossing of Butler Creek at old Emigrant
Crossing via Brassfield Perry, on Immatilla River
to intersect Pendleton & Immatilla Road

Now on this day, ^{the report of viewers on} the application of W. W. Brassfield et al coming on for a second reading the same having been read the first time on a previous day of this term of this Court to wit July 5th 1881 for a County Road leading from a point where the old Emigrant Road crosses Butler Creek in Immatilla County Oregon near the north East corner of Frank Earnings old Ranch in said County the same being the N^W 1/4 of section 26, T. 4. N. R. 27 East running thence to and across the Immatilla River at Brassfields Perry and thence easterly to the intersection of the County Road leading from Pendleton to Immatilla, and the said viewers having reported the road a practicable one and recommended its location, and it appearing to the Court that a misunderstanding of the viewers as to the terminal point exacted they viewed said road to or near Pendleton and a remonstrance having been filed against the location of said Road on account of the view and location from or near what is known as the Rock Pile on the land belonging to T. R. Hopper in sec 36. T. 3. N. R. 30 E., and it appearing that that was the intended eastern terminus of said road abtained

for and the objection of the location of the road from said starting point to or near said Rock Pile,

It is ordered by the Court, that the prayer of the Petitioners be granted in so far as it asks for a Road, beginning at said Crossing of Butter Creek at the north East Corner of Frank Ewings land claim to Brassfields ferry & thence to the intersection of an old Road leading from Puddledton to Immatilla about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile west of said rock pile, and it is further ordered by the Court that said road be and the same is hereby located and Established from said starting point to wit, Commencing at the old Emigrant Crossing of Butter Creek in said County, and near the north east Corner of Frank Ewings old Ranch in said County, the same being the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec 26 T4, R of range 27 East running thence to and across the Immatilla River at Brassfields Ferry and thence easterly to the intersection of the old road leading from Puddledton to Immatilla at a point about a $\frac{1}{2}$ mile west of the Rock pile,

And it is further ordered, that all that part of said road as per plat of A. L. Coffey as revised and laid out from said point of intersection about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile west of said Rock pile eastward towards Puddledton be and the same is hereby disallowed, and that the Clerk of this Court will duly record so much thereof as is allowed as by law required

In the Matter of County Road from
near Mr White farm to Gov Mountain.

It is ordered by the Court that the further consideration of this road and notification of miles therein be continued until April Term of this Court 1881.

Whereupon Court adjourned until tomorrow morning
