County :

1 We, the undersigned, your petitioners, who are residents and householders in Umatilla  
2 County, Oregon, and who reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County  
3 road, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located, and established,  
4 a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the SW corner of  
the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec 5 T2 NR 30 & W.M. thence  
running in North Westerly direction  
about 34 Rods, thence in South Westerly  
direction on most practicable ground  
for County road, to the center of Sec.  
6 T2 NR 30 & W.M. thence North Westerly  
about 120 Rods, thence South Westerly  
on East Side of Spears Canyon to a  
point about 10 rods above Jos. A.  
Kleins barn, thence Westerly across  
said Canyon to a point about 40  
rods west of the SE corner of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>  
Sec 11 T2 NR 29 & W.M. thence West to  
Center of said sec. thence North about  
40 rods, thence Westerly 1/2 Mile to west  
line of said Sec, thence South on Sec. line  
to SW Corner NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Sec 26 T2 NR 29 & W.M.  
Thence East about 180 rods, thence South  
about 80 rods, thence Westerly about 1/2  
Mile to Alkali Canyon, thence Southly  
up and along said Canyon about  
1 1/4 Miles to a road known as the  
Shos Ayres road leading from  
Butter Creek to Pendleton Oregon  
Said road to be 60 feet wide
