FINAL ORDER OF VACATION

Be it remembered that at a regular session of the County Court of Umatilla County, Oregon, held in the courtroom of said Court in the Temporary Umatilla County Courthouse at Pendleton, Oregon, on the 26th day of November, 1955, at 10:00 o'clock, A.M., present:

D. R. Cook, County Judge, and J. E. Olinger and Roscoe H. Kelley, County Commissioners, the following proceedings were had:

Whereas, by resolution and order unanimously adopted on the 26th day of November, 1955, it was declared that proceedings to vacate those portions of County Road #787 hereinafter described, would be undertaken, and said proceedings were instituted, and the County Engineer was notified of said proceedings and was ordered and directed to examine said portions of County Road #787 and to make a report in writing on the same as provided by law; and

Whereas, said County Engineer did examine said portion of County Road #787, and on the 7th day of December, 1955, made his report in writing thereon as required by law, and filed said report with the County Clerk of Umatilla County, Oregon and

Whereas, said notice of hearing was duly given by posting as required by law on the 8th day of December 1955, which was more than thirty days before the day set for said hearing; and proof that such notice has been given was made by affidavit of the County Engineer, now on file herein; and,

Final Order of Vacation on County Road #787 Portion.

Whereas, pursuant to said order and notice this matter came on duly to be heard by the County Court of Umatilla County, Oregon in the Courtroom of said Court in the Temporary Umatilla County Courthouse at Pendleton, Oregon on the 11th day of January 1956, at 10:00 o'clock, A.M., at which time and place the said report of the County Engineer was duly heard and considered, and the said resolution instituting said proceeding was duly considered and no objection was made by any person to the vacation of said portion of County Road #787 and,

Whereas, it appears to this Court that said portions of County Road #787 are not now in use by the public, and that they will not be a useful part of the general road system of Umatilla County, Oregon, and it further appears that the public will be benefited by the Vacation thereof; and the Court being fully advised in the premises;

It Is Hereby Ordered that the following described portions of County Road #787 of Umatilla County, Oregon, described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of Section 12, Township 1 South, Range 31 East, Willamette Meridian, running thence North on line between the East and West halves of said Section 12, a distance of about 3,917 feet, thence in a Northwesterly direction across the Northwest quarter of Section 12, and the Northeast quarter of Section 11, to intersect the open roadway at a point about 917 feet west of the Northeast corner of Section 11. The right-of-way of the aforesaid road being 40 feet.

It Is Further Ordered that this Order be entered in the Journal of this Court.
