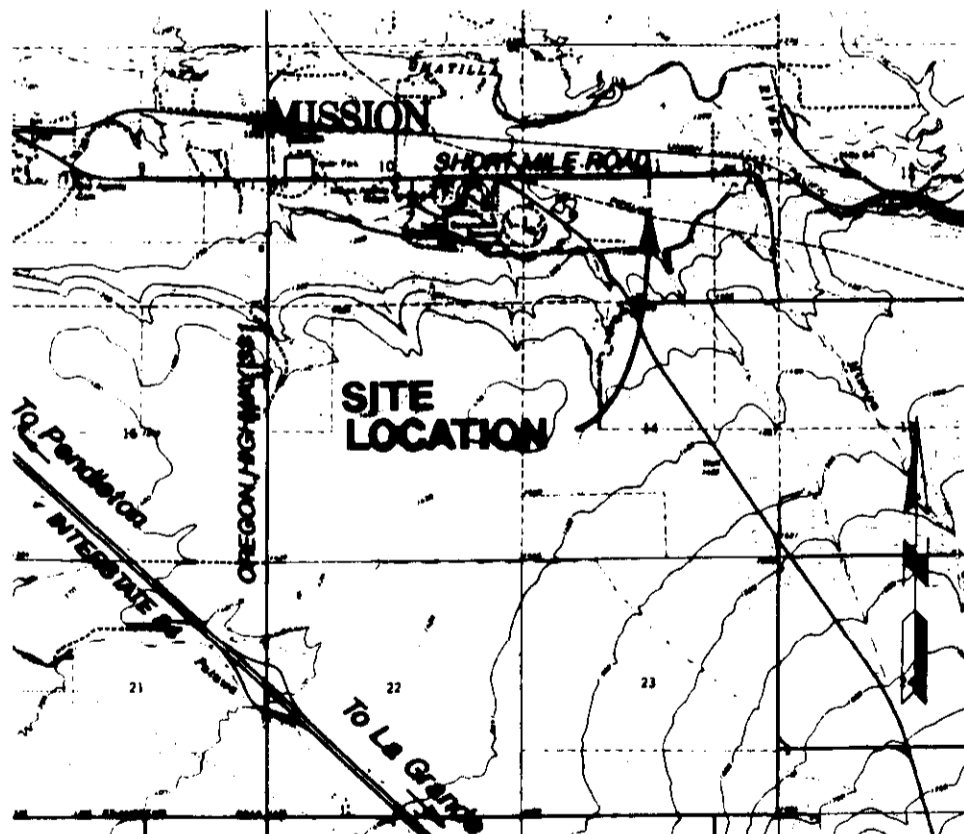
THE SIX FOOT UTILITY EASEMENTS ALONG EITHER SIDE OF ASPEN WAY, CEDAR STREET, AND JUMPER DRIVE ARE RESERVED FOR THE USE OF VARIOUS UTILITY COMPANIES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO GAS, TELEPHONE, SEWER, WATER, ELECTRIC, AND CABLE FOR THE RIGHT TO CONSTRUCT, RECONSTRUCT, OPERATE, MAINTAIN, REPAIR, REPLACE AND REMOVE ANY OR ALL EQUIPMENT AND APPURTENANCES OVER, UNDER, AND UPON SAID UTILITY EASEMENTS, TOGETHER WITH THE RIGHT TO FELL OR TRIM ANY TREE OR BRUSH THEREON.

THE TEN FOOT ROADWAY AND UTILITY EASEMENTS ALONG EITHER SIDE OF BIRCH LOOP, CHOKECHERRY LOOP, DOGWOOD LOOP, HAWTHORN LOOP, LODGEPOLE LOOP, ELDERBERRY LOOP, AND TAMARACK LOOP ARE RESERVED FOR THE PLACEMENT OF SIDEWALKS, PARKING AREAS AND DRIVEWAYS AND FOR THE USE OF VARIOUS UTILITY COMPANIES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO GAS, TELEPHONE, SEWER, WATER, ELECTRIC, AND CABLE FOR THE RIGHT TO CONSTRUCT, RECONSTRUCT, OPERATE, MAINTAIN, REPAIR, REPLACE AND REMOVE ANY OR ALL EQUIPMENT AND APPURTENANCES OVER, UNDER, AND UPON SAID UTILITY EASEMENTS, TOGETHER WITH THE RIGHT TO FELL OR TRIM ANY TREE OR BRUSH THEREON.

THE FOOT DRAINAGE EASEMENT ALONG THE SOUTH LINES OF LOTS 1 THROUGH 11 INCLUSIVE AND ALONG THE EAST LINES OF LOTS 11 AND 28 IS RESERVED FOR THE PURPOSE OF SURFACE DRAINAGE OF WATER THROUGH THE SUBDIVISION. THE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS WHICH WOULD IMPEDE THE FLOW OF SURFACE WATER, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO STRUCTURES, FENCES, ETC., IS PROHIBITED WITHIN THE LIMITS SHOWN HEREON.

THE FORTY FOOT UTILITY EASEMENT EXTENDING ACROSS THE INDIAN RESERVE FROM THE WEST SIDE OF THE SUBDIVISION IS RESERVED FOR THE USE OF VARIOUS UTILITY COMPANIES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO GAS, TELEPHONE, SEWER, WATER, ELECTRIC, AND CABLE FOR THE RIGHT TO CONSTRUCT, RECONSTRUCT, OPERATE, MAINTAIN, REPAIR, REPLACE AND REMOVE ANY OR ALL EQUIPMENT AND APPURTENANCES OVER, UNDER, AND UPON SAID UTILITY EASEMENTS, TOGETHER WITH THE RIGHT TO FELL OR TRIM ANY TREE OR BRUSH THEREON.

THE ROADWAY AND DRAINAGE EASEMENT ACROSS THE SOUTHWESTERLY CORNER OF LOT 1 IS RESERVED FOR THE PURPOSE OF ROADWAYS, SIDEWALKS, DRIVEWAYS, AND SURFACE AND SUBSURFACE DRAINAGE OF WATER THROUGH AND ACROSS THIS SUBDIVISION. THE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS WHICH WOULD IMPEDE THE FLOW OF SURFACE WATER, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO STRUCTURES, FENCES, ETC., IS PROHIBITED WITHIN THE LIMITS SHOWN HEREON.

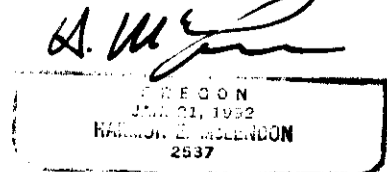
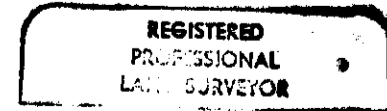


VICINITY MAP

SURVEYOR'S NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF THE CONFEDERATED TRIBES OF THE UMATILLA INDIANS FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBDIVIDING A 18 ACRE PIECE OF LAND DESCRIBED AS PARCEL 2 OF COUNTY SURVEY NO. MNP-94-01. THIS PARTITION MAP WAS DONE IN JANUARY OF 1994 BY WILLIAM R. WELLS, PLS #1106, FOR VERNON R. AND LULA M. CASE. A FIELD TRAVERSE WITH AN UNBALANCED RATIO OF PRECISION OF ONE PART IN TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND WAS RUN TO LOCATE AND VERIFY THE MONUMENTS FOUND OR SET BY MR. WELLS. NO DISCREPANCIES WERE NOTED AND THIS PLAT ACCEPTS TOTALLY THE WORK BY MR. WELLS.

IN ADDITION TO THE SUBDIVISION OF PARCEL 2 OF THE ABOVE REFERENCED MAP, ADDITIONAL LAND WAS ACQUIRED FROM LANDS ADJOINING THAT PARCEL. THESE LANDS ARE HELD IN COMMON BY THE CONFEDERATED TRIBES AND ARE REFERRED TO IN VARIOUS LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS AS THE "INDIAN RESERVE".

AS NO RECORDED INFORMATION WAS FOUND, THE RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF MISSION ROAD, COUNTY ROAD NO. 900, WAS DETERMINED BY LOCATING THE CENTERLINE OF THE EXISTING TRAVELED WAY AND ASSUMING A RIGHT-OF-WAY WIDTH OF SIXTY FEET.

SURVEYOR'S NOTES

DIMENSIONS SHOWN ARE ALONG RIGHT-OF-WAY AND LOT LINES TO THEIR INTERSECTION WITH THE RIGHT-OF-WAY. SOME INTERIOR MONUMENTS ALONG THE 20 FOOT RIGHT-OF-WAY ROADS ARE SET AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LOT LINES WITH THE 10 FOOT UTILITY EASEMENT. 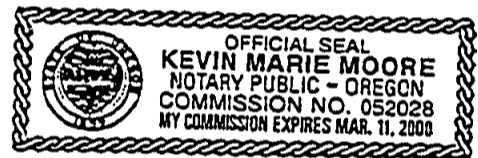

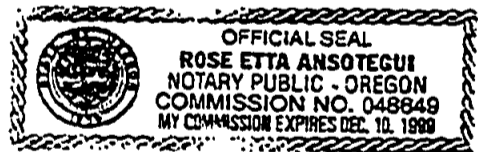
