NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey was to locate and show Mr. Scott McCallum the easterly lines and the north line of the subject property (Tr. 101) and to mark the north line. A field search was made and the monuments were found as shown. The N.W. corner monument pin was set and marked on the north line of section 16 as shown and an additional intermediate point was set for line purposes because of a hill and gully. This property is described in Book 347 on page 435 and in Roll 15 on page 1959 and in Roll 85 on page 1563 of the Umatilla County Deed Records. Survey references are:
