The purpose of this survey was to move the easterly line of TL 9200 to the west 2.50 feet as shown above. Also to mark with monuments the lot lines. As shown some monuments are off set because of various objects in the way. The two pins in front near the street were set on the old vacated right of way line because of dense shrubrey. Deeds recorded in Book 163, Pg 592 & Book 187, Pg 591 was used and the City's Monumentation Map # 24-7742 was used for reference. Bearing base is from City Map # 24-7742.
