



**NARRATIVE:**

The purpose of this survey was to locate the boundaries of the N.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 32, T1N, R35E, W.M.  
 Chris Palmer performed a survey in Nov. of 1975 for the Confederated Tribes, County Surveyor No. M-45-C, that broke down sections 19, 31 and 32.  
 In August of 1981 the Oregon Parks Division surveyed Sec. 29 and found the N.W. and N.E. corners of Sec. 32, County Surveyor No. 5-124.  
 Utilizing these surveys and tying into the corners shown, we reportioned Sec. 32 and set Brass Caps as shown.  
 Bearings are based upon County Surveyor No. M-45-C. Those shown are true.
