



NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey was to set property corners to show the partitioning of the Johnson Estate in Blocks 141 and 142, Preservation Addition to the City of Pendleton, Oregon.
 Pins found were as found and set by our firm during a survey in August of 1977. The partitioning was as directed by Cal Garton to fit the existing fences and buildings.
 Bearings are based upon the original plot of Preservation Addition.
