NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey was to establish the property boundary between Bartell and Taylor as required by the Umatilla County Circuit Court Case No. 83-7-883. The Court required that the boundary be along a windbreak of evergreen trees and an old fence line south of the windbreak. This survey was tied to corners established by Edwards Surveying as shown on County Surveyor Drwg. No. P-21-B, dated 12-4-79. Pins were also found from County Surveyor Drwg. No. G-105-A, done by Ralph Thompson. Those pins are shown and the relationship defined. Also shown are pins set by Edwards in 1950, Co. No. A-34-A and pins and a pipe set in 1952 that is shown on an unrecorded survey on file in the County Surveyor files. Bearings are based upon Highway No. 730 bearing N78°29'05\"/>
