



NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey was to establish a new boundary line between a parcel being brought by Neal and the remainder of Lot 11 belonging to Smith.

Plot bearings and distances were used between the points shown as found on the drawing. No discrepancies were found between the corners.

The new boundary line lies just to the West of a group of trees identified by Mr. Smith as being the line to use.
