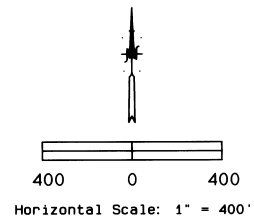
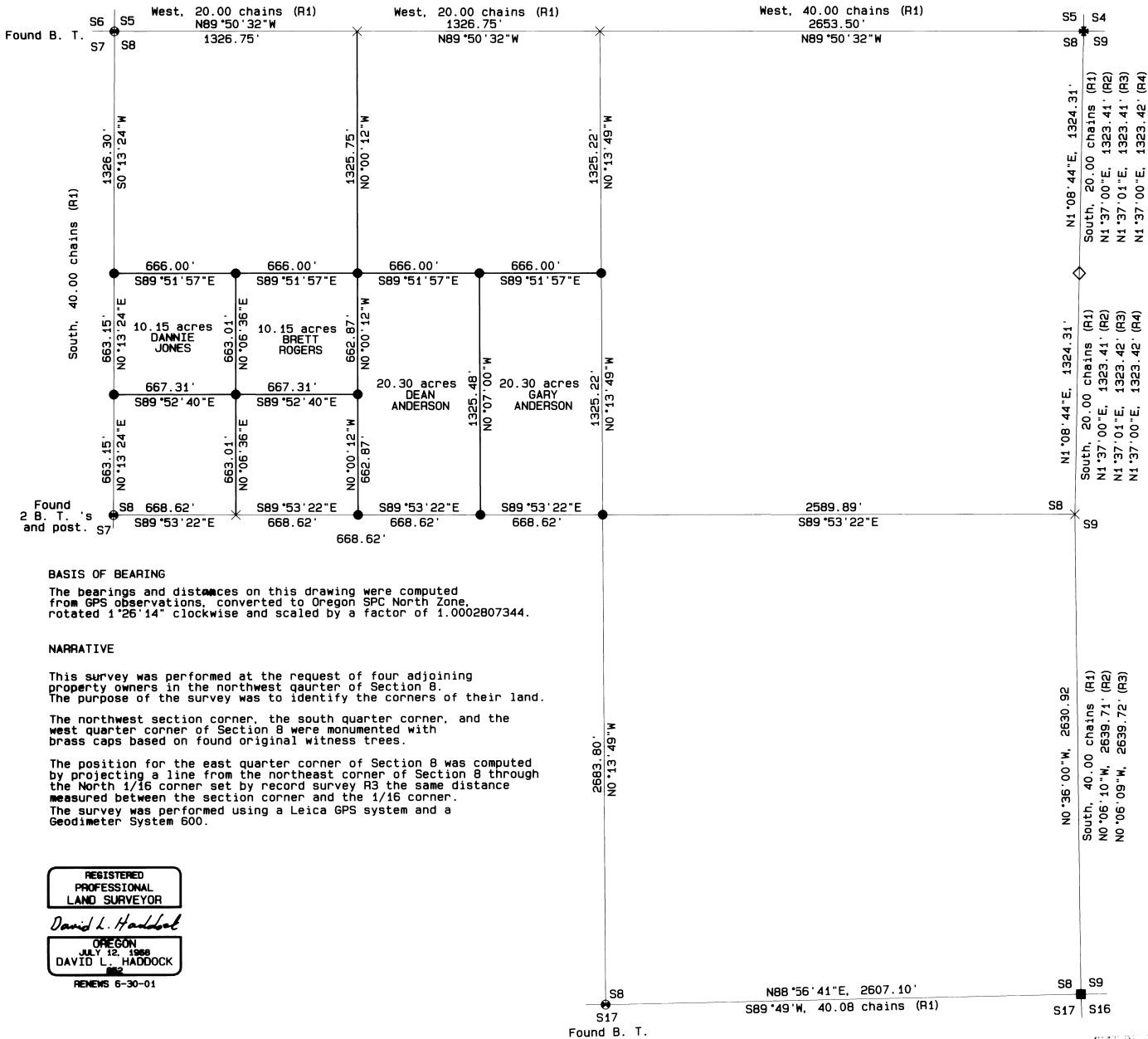

BASIS OF BEARING
The bearings and distances on this drawing were computed from GPS observations, converted to Oregon SPC North Zone, rotated 1°26'14" clockwise and scaled by a factor of 1.0002807344.

NARRATIVE
This survey was performed at the request of four adjoining property owners in the northwest quarter of Section 8. The purpose of the survey was to identify the corners of their land. The northwest section corner, the south quarter corner, and the west quarter corner of Section 8 were monumented with brass caps based on found original witness trees. The position for the east quarter corner of Section 8 was computed by projecting a line from the northeast corner of Section 8 through the North 1/16 corner set by record survey R3 the same distance measured between the section corner and the 1/16 corner. The survey was performed using a Leica GPS system and a Geodimeter System 600.
