NARRATIVE
 The purpose of this survey was to survey and describe an existing fence line as the boundary between lands belonging to Pete French and Margaret Fahrenwald. The Northeast and Southeast corners of Section 27 were found as shown. The fence was tied at the major angle points and 3/8" x 30" iron rebars with an aluminum cap marked "KEL 933" were set as shown. Section 27 was not broken down by survey and the ownerships are shown only for clarity.

- denotes 1/2" Brass Cap on 2 1/2" galvanized iron pipe set by BLM-1978, 4 bearing trees with signs and scribe marks as noted on monumentation sheets
- denotes set 3/8" x 30" iron pin with aluminum cap stamped PLS 933
- denotes set 2 1/2" Brass Cap on 1" galvanized iron pipe from two bearing trees
