None. There are several old rock jacks in the area indicating different fence locations.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description) Set a 2" aluminum cap on a 1" x 24" iron rebar driven into the bedrock, stamped as shown in the diagram above at the intersection of an east - west fence and the township line. I built a 2 foot diameter mound of stone around the monument.

For references, I set four, 5/8" by 24" iron rebars with 1 1/4" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below: an iron rebar bears N77°36'16"W, 65.58 feet; an iron rebar bears N28°12'20"E, 125.09 feet; an iron rebar bears S82°33'31"E, 105.06 feet; an iron rebar bears S32°19'34"W, 68.47 feet;
